Submitting Corrected Code

- 1. Comment out incorrect code and explain why it is incorrect.
 - Do not completely remove incorrect code.
- 2. Write correct code underneath and explain why it is now correct.
- 3. You can make changes to your code, even if they are not strictly necessary, IF there is a valid reason.
 - However, these reasons must be fully explained.
 - e.g.
- This is more efficient and less long winded than my solution because
- I like the style of this change more because ...
- 4. However, do NOT make unnecessary changes to your code
 - i.e. Do not copy and paste standard solutions and totally replace your code if this is not necessary.
- 5. You should have executed your corrected code to make sure it now works perfectly, BEFORE submitting corrections.
- 6. Please add the word "Corrections" before your name to the filename (the same to the class name if sending a Java file).
